in the **Global Young Academy (GYA) Office,** currently hosted at the BBAW in Berlin, Germany. The position is available from 1 September 2016 to 31 December 2016 with a fixed-term contract and the intention to be extended for up to four years from 1 January 2017, then between 50 and 75% and based in Halle/Saale at the Leopoldina.

The Global Young Academy (GYA) is a vibrant international organisation. It was founded in 2010 with the vision to be the voice of young scientists around the world. The GYA empowers young early- and mid- career researchers to lead international and interdisciplinary initiatives and projects. Its purpose is to promote reason and inclusiveness in global decision-making. Members are chosen for their demonstrated excellence in academic achievement and commitment to service. The Media Officer will serve GYA with its 200 members and a growing network of alumni from around the world and across the disciplines. We search for a person who is eager to learn and help GYA to develop its network and the growing opportunities to be a well respected voice in addressing global challenges. The academy is hosted at the Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities (BBAW) in Berlin until the end of 2016 and will be hosted at the German National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina in Halle/Saale from January 2017 (pending funding). The GYA receives core-funding from the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF), is supported by the InterAcademy Partnership (IAP), and benefits from project funding from a variety of other donors and partners. The Media Officer (75%) will be in charge of media production as well as the support and development of the IT infrastructure of the organisation. This includes amongst other things, the following:

- conceptualisation and production of digital and visual media, e.g. print- and online publications
- mediation of the work of the Global Young Academy (i.e. strategic development of media channels of GYA)
- further development of applications of the corporate design and house style
- maintenance and further development of the website and intranet of the GYA
- project management and liaising with the IT department of BBAW/Leopoldina and cooperation with external service providers supporting the GYA with specialised tasks, including issuing corresponding calls for bids
- support of the organisation in further strategic development of the IT infrastructure
- · maintenance and further development of digital tools for internal communication and collaboration
- support the membership and working groups in the conceptualisation and implementation of new and improvement of existing media products and digital projects
- user-support of (web-based) software-tools in use within the organisation
- maintenance of web-based software-tools (partially in cooperation with external service providers)
- · management of digital communication channels e.g. twitter and facebook
- further tasks related to PR and communication of the organisation

Requirements

- A completed academic education with at least a Master's degree in a relevant subject
- Relevant professional experience in the area media production / design as well as media technology and IT infrastructure, demonstrated through a portfolio of relevant projects (online or as PDF)
- Excellent knowledge of the Adobe Creative Cloud
- Proficient in work with CMS systems and other web-based software
- Ideally prior knowledge in maintaining web-servers and web-based software products
- Fluent command of English and German

- International interest and experience
- Intercultural sensitivity and competencies
- Excellent references and relevant prior experience
- Readiness to travel, mainly internationally
- Thorough knowledge of digital media, including the latest social media platforms
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- · Creativity, good presentation and organisational skills

The payment will be based on E13 (Angleichungs-TV Land Berlin). The contract will be limited to a term congruent with the current core-funding of the GYA (ending on 31 December 2016). Pending future funding there is the intention for continuing to work with the GYA at the Leopoldina in Halle/Saale on a separate contract from January 2017 (then TVöD-Bund).
