

GYA Webinar: COVID-19 in Latin America - perspectives from young scientists 14 May 2020, from 18:00 to 20:00 UTC

A group of GYA members from Latin America are organising a webinar titled "Covid-19 in Latin America: perspectives from young scientists" on 14 May 2020, from 18:00 to 20:00 UTC. Due to historically low expenditures on public health and other structural problems, Latin America faces the COVID-19 pandemic from a weak and vulnerable position. As such, the challenges in this region are harder in comparison with the rest of the world. This webinar brings together six Latin American scientists, all members of the GYA, in order to discuss with the general public (in Spanish) their perspectives on this crisis.

The webinar will consist of short talks, and Q&A with the participants. Questions such as How did we get to this situation? What are Latin American virologists doing? How to transfer scientific knowledge to the political arena? What emerging technologies are being used in other parts of the world to deal with the pandemic? will be discussed.
