

Information Provided as Mandated by Article 13 GDPR

Art. 12, 13 GDPR mandates that we make available to you the following mandatory data protection related information: Pursuant to Art. 6 of the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), processing of personal data is only admissible if at least one of the conditions of Art. 6 (1) GDPR is fulfilled. Among other things, Art. 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR provides that processing shall be lawful only if the person concerned has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.

When admitting new members to the GYA members & alumni network and in the subsequent years, the GYA collects personal data for the following purposes linked to the GYA membership and the role the GYA thus takes:

- Creating, updating, processing member and alumni statistics
- (analogue and digital) lists and databases
- correspondence (postal mail / email) including but not limited to invitations to GYA activities (events, working groups and committees, or other responsibilities)
- GYA publications (e.g., press releases, articles, brochures, websites, newsletters, bulletins, videos, podcasts, internal and external reports, social media campaigns [Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Flickr, Instagram]. topical publications by GYA activity groups) or other forms of campaigns and communications of similar fashion
- Preparation, execution and evaluation of events and / or ceremonies

GYA will store and process your data for the aforementioned purposes until you request deletion of the data or revoke your consent to store the data or if the purpose to store the data no longer exists (e.g., once your request has been conclusively processed). This shall be without prejudice to any compelling statutory provisions – in particular tax and commercial law-based retention periods.

In accordance with Art. 15 GDPR, you are entitled any time to receive free information concerning the origins, recipients and purpose of your data archived by us. You also have a right to object, to data portability and a right to log a complaint with the competent supervisory agency.

Moreover, pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR, you can demand the correction, eradication and, under certain circumstances, the restriction of the processing of your personal data. For more details, please consult our [Data Privacy Policy](#).
